

Re-Klaim IT -Device distribution and support programme

Improving Our Community One Day At A Time to improve Digital Exclusion Together with Digital Innovation London Borough of Ealing



Qualification Criteria

The Council and partners identify the residents of Ealing who require a device

- Residents living in social housing are digitally excluded and isolated.
- Multiple deprivation families using food banks.
- Individuals who access support services.
- Individuals who identify themselves as long-term unemployed.
- Minority communities.
- Eligible or receiving means tested benefits, low waged, or NEET
- Must not already have easy access to devices / internet in their home
- Agree that they are happy for the EHCVS to 'check in' at regular intervals via 30,60 and 90 days surveys to find out how they have progressed.

Vulnerability Criteria

- Children and young person's having left or leaving care
- Mental Health
- Physical and Learning Disabilities
- Substance Misuse
- Long term Health issues
- Homelessness
- Ex- offenders
- Victim of domestic abuse
- Loan Parent and Troubled Families
- Socially isolated or any other complex needs

LBE Referral Partners & Process

- LBE Employment, learning and skills
- Steps4Success (Partnership between Ealing Council and Jobcentre Plus)
- Local Welfare Assistance
- Children's social services, including Connexions, youth provision, and youth justice Internal communications will target other appropriate key teams within the council to ensure there is a wide awareness of the scheme outlining how to make referrals.

Process:

- Individual matching the criteria is identified.
- Needs of individual are determined. Do they need a device, data and access to digital training?
- Referral made to EHCVS RE-Klaim IT.
- Distribution of device etc alongside set up guides, signposting to other support available including information regarding adult learning courses.
